Majority of inhabitants of this System are refugees from Liberty and Rheinland Houses. This is reflected by the unruly behavior of people living here who are also very tolerant to space piracy and other criminal activities. A local safe "neutral zone" exists only in close proximity to the [Freeport 2](#) station, which is controlled by the [Zoners](#), and is connected by fast Trade Lane corridors to jump-gates leading to the [Texas](#) and [Hamburg](#) Systems. The rest of System is ruled by the radical [Unioners](#) operating from their [Pacifica Base](#), which was built west of [Freeport 2](#) in one of the big asteroids of the Tanner Belt which covers most of local space in Bering. In bars at [Freeport 2](#), you hear rumours that the [Unioners](#) have found, and frequently use, unstable jump-holes to travel to other Systems.
